The Home team will:

- Sit on the North or East side
- Provide the game ball
- Wear the pennies if there is a color conflict.

The ball is out of play only for the following two reasons:

- a. The whole ball has crossed the goal-line or touch-line on the ground or in the air. If any part has not crossed the line it is still in play.
- b. When the Referee stops play for any reason.

Substitution may be made only with the consent of the Referee:

- prior to your throw-in
- prior to a goal kick, by either team
- after a goal by either team
- after an injury if the Referee stops play, by either team
- at half time
- you **cannot** substitute prior to corner Kicks

Goal differential during a game should never exceed 6 goals.

Each player shall play a minimum of 50% of the game.

**Coaches must remain behind the middle third of the touchline during play.
 Coaches or parents are not allowed at the corners or behind the goal line.**
